Every parent/guardian with a child enrolled at Queen Elizabeth Elementary School (QE) is automatically a member of the school's Parent Advisory Council (PAC). The role of the PAC is to provide advice to the school about matters of importance to parents. The PAC also provides financial support through fundraising activities and logistical support through volunteering at special events and activities. Much of the communication between the PAC and the school happens at the monthly scheduled PAC meetings.

For the 2023/2024 school year, PAC meeting dates and times will be determined at a future date once the new executive has been determined. Since Covid, the meetings have been taking place in an online format, which may continue to happen depending on member's availability. If meetings go back to in person, childcare will be an option so parents can attend the meetings. We will be updating this information closer to the start of the 2023/2024 school year.

Each year parents elect an Executive to carry out the business of the Parent Advisory Council.

- Vice-President Special committees and projects
- Treasurer Complete gaming account application / book-keeping / cash to bank
- Secretary Takes minutes and collects mail
- **DPAC member** Attends DPAC meetings (3 hours every 3rd Monday of the month) and report up and back.
- **Members at large (not elected)** Helps with anything PAC related Pizza day, fundraisers, community events etc, opinions and ideas! No need to nominate for this just come!
